Portrait of Lord David Rowe-Beddoe

A successful international businessman, Lord David Rowe-Beddoe was knighted in the year 2000 and elevated to the peerage in 2006 for services to industry and economic development in Wales.

A graduate of Cambridge University and an alumnus of Harvard, he is currently Deputy Chairman of Toye and Co and has previously been president of both Revlon and Morgan Stanley GFTA.

Lord Rowe-Beddoe is greatly committed to public services and works within the Arts. He is a fellow of the Royal Society of Arts and was Chairman of the Welsh Development Agency from 1993-2001. He is also Pro Chancellor at the University of Glamorgan. Among his most notable achievements, in his role as chairman he has been instrumental in the creation of the Wales Millennium Centre, (famously featured in the BBC series *Torchwood*) which opened in 2004 and has established a reputation as one of the world's iconic arts and cultural destinations.



In the portrait Lord Rowe-Beddoe is shown at his home in Wales. A music scholar and son of the opera singer Dolan Evans, he is pictured with some of his favourite musical works. Around the painting are references to his life; one such reference is the bowl on top of the piano which is a design in Welsh Gaudy.
